Heat transition vision (TVW)

The municipality of The Hague has drawn up a draft transition vision for the heat network. It describes techniques for heating with clean energy for each neighborhood in The Hague. In addition, it is indicated which neighborhoods will probably have a clean heat supply before 2030 and which will switch to a clean heat supply after 2030. In the coming years, a large part of the houses and buildings will be adapted to this change. For many older neighborhoods, including the Van Stolkpark, it is still unclear which direction we are heading.

The municipality published the draft transition vision for heat on February 23, 2022. Residents and other involved parties can respond to this in a consultation procedure. The consultation period lasts until May 23.

On Wednesday 13 April 19:30 – 21:00 there will be an information meeting in Theater Dakota, Zuidlarenstraat 57, 2545 VP The Hague, Southwest.

During the information meeting you can ask questions about the transition vision for heat to experts and the municipality and there is time to start a discussion together. You will receive information about how The Hague can switch to clean energy in the future. For example: How can we insulate homes better so that we use less energy? What is a heat network? It also explains how you can respond to the concept of transition vision heat.
